

Election Meeting

October 2, 2025

Call The Meeting to Order

Darrell Spurrell called the meeting to order at 7:02pm

Introduction of Election Presiding Officer

Darrell Spurrell introduced himself and outlined his qualifications to conduct the election. He asked Kevin O'Regan to record the minutes of the meeting. He explained the changes to the process from the way that our LSD has held elections, and answered several questions from the floor. He explained that the only order of business for the meeting was the election, and other questions would be answered by the new committee at a later date. He asked and confirmed that all members present had signed the registration list.

Decision on the Committee Size

Darrell Spurrell explained under the new process, that the members present at the election meeting would decide the size of the new committee, and there was an option to continue with a 5-person committee or continue as historically with a 7-person committee. Again, there was discussion from the floor. After the discussion ended, he explained that the vote on committee size would not be a secret vote and would be a show of hands. The results were:

5 Person Committee	5 votes
7 Person Committee	36 votes

Darrell Spurrell declared that the new committee would be as before with 7 members.

Nomination Process and Election

Darrell Spurrell explained how the election process would work, with nominations called first for the 4 Full-time Resident seats on the committee and then the process would repeat for the 3 Seasonal Resident seats. If more nominations were received than seats, then a secret ballot vote would take place. He also listed the qualifications as provided to run for office.

Darrell then called for nominations for Full-time Resident Positions. Prior to calling for nominations, he stated that David Hiscock had sent an email advising that he would accept a nomination if he was infact nominated.

Craig Hiscock nominated **David Hiscock**. Seconded by Brenda O'Regan. Darrell Spurrell confirmed that David Hiscock had accepted the nomination.

Brad Boland nominated **Dave Chaulk**. Seconded by Daniel LaChance. Dave Chaulk accepted the nomination.

Keith Ryan nominated **Matthew Daley**. Seconded by Jim Buckingham. Matthew Daley accepted the nomination.

Carolyn Penney nominated **John Hussey**. Seconded by Terry Penney. John Hussey accepted the nomination.

Lisa Walsh nominated **Daniel LaChance**. Seconded by Rolanda Ryan. Daniel LaChance accepted the nomination.

Charlie Noseworthy nominated **Corey Butler**. Seconded by Dave Chaulk. Corey Butler accepced the nomination.

Darrell then called three times "for any more nominations?". There were none, so he declared nominations closed and stated that there would be an election for the Full-time committee seats.

Darrell then called for nominations for the Season Seats on the committee.

Corey Butler nominated **Charlie Noseworthy**. Seconded by Matthew Daley. Charlie Noseworthy accepted the nomination.

Bob Anstey nominated **Jim Buckingham**. Seconded by Ian Henderson. Jim Buckingham accepted the nomination.

Brenda O'Regan nominated **Kevin O'Regan**. Seconded by Jim Buckingham. Kevin O'Regan accepted the nomination.

Darrell then called three times "for any more nominations?". There were none, so he declared nominations closed and declared **elected by acclimation as Seasonal Committee Members:**

Election Process

Darrell Spurrell then explained the election process. Candidates' names were written on a flipchart at the front of the room. Members would come forward, be checked off the registration list, and be issued a ballot. The ballot would be marked in secret, placed in the box and counted after all were completed.

Darrell asked Brenda O'Regan to write the names on the board in the order that they were nominated.

He asked for two volunteers to assist him with the counting; Janie Betts and Carolyn Penney offer and were selected.

Members completed ballots, and once that was done, the ballot box was opened and the ballots counted at the front of the room.

Darrell Spurrell Announced the results of the vote:
